OUTDOOR PLAY - Children play outside in all but extreme weather conditions, please ensure that your children come to school with suitable outdoor clothing. They may bring play clothes to change into as they are discouraged from playing on the grass wearing school uniform when it is muddy.

Occasionally, children may need a change of clothes, usually we will use their PE kit but may loan them school items. PLEASE return our school clothing as soon as possible. We would also appreciate donations of outgrown school clothing for this use.

INHALERS – If your child has an inhaler for asthma, an information form must be completed and signed each term - these are available from the office. Children in Key Stage 2 are expected to take responsibility for looking after their own inhalers, but we need up to date information on record. Teachers in Key Stage 1 will look after children's inhalers but it is your responsibility to collect them at the end of each term and to ensure that medication is in date. ALL INHALERS SHOULD BE CLEARLY NAMED.

HOLIDAYS IN TERM TIME - A reminder that except in very extreme circumstances holidays in term time cannot be authorised. If children are absent from school for holidays without prior permission, they will be registered as unauthorised absence and a penalty notice may be issued by the LA.
