**PARENT AND CHILD TRAVEL SURVEY** – Your child brought home a questionnaire yesterday as part of our ongoing commitment to providing ease of access to the school. Please complete the survey and return to school by this Friday. Thank you.

**SCHOOL EXPANSION:** Following on from last week's question, this week covers another question I have received numerous times: 'My child is joining in September 2019, how will they go through the school?'

When our 2019 joiners come to school they will be in 2 reception classes of twenty two or twenty three children, each with their own staff. They will then move to one of three Year 1/2 classes with twenty five children in each class (fifteen Year 1 children, and ten year Year 2 children who joined our school in 2018). When the 2019 joiners move to Year 2, they will remain in a Year 1/2 class, only they will now be the Year 2 children and there will be fifteen Year 1 children joining them (2020 joiners), so each class will be thirty children.

When 2019 joiners move to Year 3, they will revert back to being in a class of twenty five, again meeting the 2018 joiners, so each Year 3/4 class will have fifteen Year 3 children and ten Year 4 children. As before, when the 2019 joiners move to Year 4 they will remain in the Year 3/4 class, and once again have the 2020 joiners in their class, making thirty children per class (15 2019 joiners and 15 2020 joiners).

This will repeat in Year 5 and 6. As before, these diagrams hope to lend clarity:
